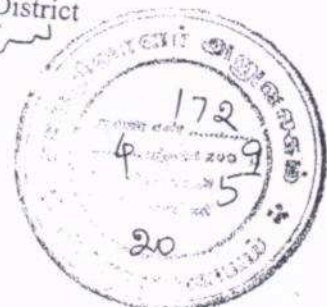

hereinafter called "TRUSTEES" which expression shall unless repugnant to the subject or context here of mean and include the survivor of them and all such persons as are or may be duly appointed as Trustees under the provisions contained in these presents and the Trustees or Trustees for the time being of these presents of the OTHER PART

WHEREAS the settlor has been desirous of establishing a public Charitable Trust for the objects hereinafter mentioned.

WHEREAS the settlor with a view to give effect to the said desire constituted a Trust, appointed the Trustees named above numbering 1 to 31 of the First Trustees of the Trust and the Trustees have consented to act as trustees;

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH AND IT IS HEREBY AGREED AND DECLARED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The settlor hereby declares that the aforesaid sum of Rs.10000/- (Rupees Ten thousand Only) and all further donations and contributions and any other property that may hereafter be given, transferred to the Trust by the settlor or others and the interest, rent, dividend, profits, and other income thereof (hereinafter referred to as "The Trust Property") shall be held upon by trust for the objects and purposes hereinafter mentioned and subject to the powers and provisions hereafter declared and contained of and concerning the same.

NAME OF THE TRUST

1. The Trust hereby declared and constituted is a public charitable Trust and shall be known as "SREE VAARI TRUST" with its headquarters at B. Komarapalayam, Namakkal District.



REGISTERED OFFICE OF THE TRUST

1. The Registered office of the Trust for the time being, shall be situated at the following address, 10/4, M.A.N. Complex, Newpallipalayam Road, B.Komarapalayam, Namakkal District - 638183. And the Board of Trustees may shift the Registered Office of the Trust to any place from time to time as and when they decide to do so.

OBJECTS OF THE TRUST

1. The Objects of the trust are as under:

a) The trust is established as a secular, educational, social and charitable non-political, non-profit organization for promoting Education and Social welfare for the benefit of the public irrespective of their caste and creed with the social emphasis for fostering communal harmony among all sections of the society and no activities of the trust shall be carried on outside India.

b) To establish, run, maintain, and/or promote Play School, Nursery School, Primary School, Elementary Schools, Matriculation, Higher Secondary Schools, Public Schools, International Schools, affiliated to State Education Board, Central Board of Secondary Education, I.C.S.C, Collegiate Education, Teacher Training Institute, Nursing college, Paramedical Course, Veterinary Science, Art and Science College, Engineering Colleges, Medical Colleges, Polytechnic College, Industrial Training Institute, Technological Research Institutions and to maintain all other educational Institutions for the benefit of the people.

c) To establish, organize and conduct Community Halls, Libraries, reading rooms, scientific and industrial museums, laboratories, workshops, hostels, canteen, book bank, E-Book bank and transport facilities etc., for benefits of the students of the Educational Institutions run by this Trust. To promote cultural activities and scientific knowledge through this Trust.

- d) To establish, maintain or grant aid to homes for the aged, orphanages or other establishments for the relief and help to the poor, needy and destitute people, orphaned, widows and aged persons, To establish and run Charitable Dispensaries, Hospitals, Clinics, Medical camp and Centers to give Medical relief to poor and mostly backward people.
- e) To enter into any agreement with or apply for and accept from any Government or authorities, local, Municipal or otherwise any rights, privileges and concessions which the Trust may think desirable to obtain;
- f) To grant aid or render assistance to other public charitable trusts or institutions having objects similar to this Trust. To accept donations of Money, Lands, Buildings, Machineries and Properties of Other Individual, Association Trust and Society having objects similar to this Trust.
- g) To sell, Mortgage, pledge surplus lands of the Trust and to utilize the proceeds for the improvement and Promotion of the Educational Institutions of the Trust.
- h) To promote, establish, support, maintain or grant aids to Institutions for the promotion of science, literature, music, drama and fine arts for the preservation of historical monuments and for the Research by other institutions, in India, having similar objects for the benefit of the public in general.
- i) To Educate the illiterate and the poor and weaker sections of the Society. To provide financial assistance to poor and meritorious students to proceed higher studies and for research.
- j) To provide facilities for adult Education and continuing Education who desire and are, fit to undergo further training in any educational field and to those who need continual growth and development.

- k) To provide special aid and services for the Fraternity of Teacher's Scholarships, Students Assistantships and Fellowship. To spread knowledge and Education by the publication Books, Audio/Video/Digital & Press, Classics and other literature and /or by establishment of specific endowments and memorials for public charitable purpose.
- l) To aid and assist the advancement of any other object of general public utility. To establish and develop Institutions for the physically handicapped and disabled or mentally retarded persons and to provide them education, food, clothing or other help.
- m) To do social service for the lower strata of people and to help improvement in their status. To undertake rural development programme.
- n) To award scholarships, grants, contributions to individuals for promoting studies, Institutions, colleges, imparting such general and technical education to the public.
- o) To receive donations in cash or in kind from the public and/or from members of the Trust for the attainment of the objects of the Trust. To apply the Income and property of the Trust whatsoever derived solely towards the promotion of the objects of the society as is set forth in the Trust Deed and no portion shall be paid or transferred to the Trust Members.
- p) To do all such things as may be necessary or conducive for the advancement of the objects above mentioned. To carry on all other activities of Charitable and Educational nature. The above objects are independent to each other and the trustees herein are at liberty to carry on one or more of the objects specified above or to stop one or more of the objects as may become necessary from time to time.
- q) To safeguard the autonomy of the Principals of all Educational Institutions of this Trust and provide him total support except when the Principal goes against the established and clear directives laid down by the management.

r) To control manage over the School and College management committies and shall approve the budget/tuition fees and annual charges etc., for the school and colleges. To control over any capital expenditure i.e., on land and the construction of building, its expansion and procurement of major equipments for the school and colleges.

s) To provide the basic essential facilities such as laboratory equipment for games, sports and other co curricular activities, library books etc., for the schools and colleges. To constitute Selection Committee/Departmental Promotion Committees for various categories of staff. To lay down conditions of services as per norms of affiliating Institutions/Government and to approve promotion /appointment/termination of the employees as well as to grant special increments or reward to the staff.

5. The benefit of the Trust shall be available to all the people Irrespective of Caste, Creed, Community, Religion or Sex etc.,

DONATIONS AND CONTRIBUTIONS

6. The Trustees shall have power and discretion to accept upon such terms as they shall think fit, any donations, grants, subscriptions, aids and contributions from the Founders and from any other agencies, corporations, organizations, institutions, individuals whether they be in cash or in other movable or immovable property for the purposes of the Trust. PROVIDED ALWAYS that the terms upon which they shall be accepted shall not any way be inconsistent with or repugnant to the provisions contained in these presents and the objects of the Trust. The Trustees, shall apply such donations, grants, aids, subscriptions and contributions for all or any of the object of the Trust keeping in view the intentions of the donors.

(ii) The above mentioned trustees are life trustees

(iii) If the life trustee in unavoidable circumstances willing to relive himself from the trust he shall announce his legal heir.

(iv) The Trustee may retire from the Trusteeship by giving notice in writing to the Managing Trustee. The Trustee is discharged when he resigns voluntarily.

(v) The Board of Trustees may appoint one or more persons as Co-Trustees and such Co-opted Trustees shall hold office for their life time or until they resign their trusteeship.

(vi) Any Trustee shall be liable to be dismissed from the trusteeship if he/she is adjudged insolvent or found insane or found guilty in a court administering criminal law.

(vii) A Trustee shall also be liable to be expelled from the Trusteeship, if his/her actions are adverse to the interests of the Trust.

POWER OF TRUSTEES

10. The Trustees shall have all powers necessary or incidental for effectively carrying out the objects of the Trust.

11. subject to the general provisions of the Trust and without prejudice to the general and specified powers conferred upon the Trustees by the other provisions contained in these presents, the Trustees shall have the following powers also.

(i) To apply the Trust moneys and properties for fulfilling one or some of the objects of the Trust in preference to the other objects:

(ii) To decide the nature, objects and functions of the institutions to be established by the Trust and to decide whether and if so which existing institutions may be taken over by the Trust or to which financial aid may be given to achieve the objects of the Trusts.

(iii) In case if it is decided to render financial or other aid to any person or institution to decide what terms and conditions should be complied with by such person or institution, consistent with the objects of the Trust.

(iv) To determine the terms and conditions on which any donations, subscriptions, scholarships or prizes are to be given by the Trust

(v) To expand the funds of the trust in such manner as they shall consider most beneficial for the purpose of the Trust.

(vi) To acquire any property in exchange for some other property or partly for such exchange and partly for other consideration and to sell, demise, lease, give out on lease and/or license, give in exchange, transfer, surrender, dispose of, take or give for hire, pledge, hypothecate or mortgage the property movable or immovable for the time being belonging to the Trust in such manner and on such terms as the Trustees may deem fit.

(vii) To borrow or raise money for the purpose of the Trust at such rates of interest and upon such terms as may be agreed to and to draw, make, accept, discount, execute and issue cheques, promissory notes, and other negotiable or transferable instruments.

(viii) To make and from time to time to repeal, add or alter regulations:-

- a. as to the management of the Trust and affairs thereof:
- b. as to the duties and remuneration of any officers or servants of the Trust:
- c. as to the conduct of any of the matters or things within the powers or under the control of the Trustees provided that the same shall not be inconsistent with the provisions in these presents and repugnant to the provisions of Section 2 (15), 11, 12, 13 and 80(G) of the Income-tax Act, 1961 and any amendment made in the provisions of the Said Act from time to time.

(ix) To institute, conduct, defend, legal proceeding by or against the Trust and its trustees and to settle out of court, compromise or compound all suits, actions and other proceedings and all differences or demands to arbitrations and executed releases and to settle and approve all accounts without being answerable for any loss occasioned thereby.

(x) To appoint, employ, and dismiss managers, secretaries, clerks and other staff, workers and agents required for the management of the affairs of the Trust, and to do all such lawful things as may incidental to, or conducive to the attainment of the objects of the Trust.

(xi) A Trustee resigning his office or otherwise ceasing to be a trustee shall not by any reason of that fault allowed to be relieved from his liability to the trust or to his co-trustees in respect of his acts of commission or omission or defaults during the period of his trusteeship, no trustee shall be made liable for the acts or defaults of his predecessors.

(xii) This trust is secular and non political, therefore the trustees shall not involve the trust with the actions which will affect the religious harmony of the society and people of this country and shall not execute or entertain political actions within the trust.

(xiii) BORROWING POWERS:- To borrow money for the purpose of the Trust or Institutions from Bank or any other Financial Institution and to execute necessary documents as may be required by the Bank or Financial Institution to secure the payment of money borrowed. All the Trustees should jointly execute the loan documents or in alteration the Managing Trustee can execute the documents on behalf of another as power agent if he holds a power of Attorney-executed in his favor.

PROCEEDINGS OF THE TRUST

12. The Trustees shall hold of such meetings as may from time to time be necessary considering any matter connected with the Trust. These meetings may be held at such places as the Chairman may decide.

13. The Trustees may make rules for regulating their meeting not being inconsistent with any provisions contained in these present and they may make rules for passing any resolutions by circulation among Trustees and the Trustees may repeal or alter any rules made pursuant to this clauses.

14. A meeting of the Trustees may be called by the Chairman with not less than seven days notice in writing specifying the date, place and time of such meeting and the nature of the business to be transacted at the meeting. The notice shall be sent by post or delivered to every Trustee. The accidental omission to give notice to or the non-receipt of notice by any Trustee shall not invalidate the proceeding at any such meeting. With the consent of all the Trustees a meeting may be convened by such shorter notice and in such manner as the Trustees may think fit.

15. In the matter of investing or exercising the borrowing powers or selling or disposing of any of the assets of the Trust, the decision of the Board of Trustees at a meeting shall be necessary.
16. The Chairman of the Trust shall preside as the Chairman at every meeting of the Trustees, but if the Chairman of the Trust is not present at any meeting, the Trustees shall choose one amongst them to be the Temporary Chairman of the meeting.
17. On any matter in which there is no unanimity of opinion among all the Trustees the decision of the majority shall prevail. If there are only two Trustees their unanimous decisions shall be necessary. In case there is an equal division of votes where an even number of trustees attend the meeting, the chairman of the meeting shall have an additional casting vote.
18. A minute book shall be maintained in which shall be recorded the proceedings of every meeting of the Trust and it shall be signed by the Chairman of the meeting.
19. The continuing Trustee or Trustees may act notwithstanding any vacancy in their body.
20. All acts done by the Trustees or any of them or by any person acting on the instruction of any Trustee shall notwithstanding that it be afterwards discovered that there was defect in the appointment of any Trustee or that any Trustee was disqualified, be as valid as if every such person had been duly appointed and was qualified to be a Trustee.
21. Any Trustee may at any time with the consent of all his co-trustees delegate all or any of his duties or powers to any other person or persons, whether such persons or persons is/are co-trustee or Trustees or not. However, the meeting of the Trustees shall be attended by the Trustees themselves.
22. The Trustees shall be entitled to reimbursement of all expenses including boarding, lodging, all traveling and out of pocket expenses incurred by them for the purpose of the Trust.

23. The Board of Trustees are entitled to open a Bank Account/Accounts in the name of the Trust or in the name of the Educational Institutions run by the /trust and such Account/Accounts shall be operated by the Managing Trustee, Jointly with either Secretary or Treasurer. The Secretary or Treasurer will be elected in the Board meeting of the Trustees.

24. The Trustees shall arrange for the maintenance of correct and proper account of all receipts and payments for the year ending 31st March of every year and for proper audit of the accounts of the Trust every year by a qualified Chartered Accountant.

25. It is expressly declared that no part of the Trust or its Income or any accretion thereto shall applied for any purpose outside India or for any purpose which is not a charitable purpose in law, and all provision hereof shall be constructed accordingly.

26. No income or funds of the Trust shall be utilized either directly or indirectly for the benefit of the Trustees. The Income and Funds of the Trust and no portion of it will be utilized for payment to trustees by the way of profit, interest, dividends etc and benefits of the Trust shall be open to all irrespective of caste, religion, sex etc.

27. a) The excess funds of the Trust after application to the objectives of the fund shall be invested only in the modes specified under the provisions of section 13(i) (d) read with section 11(5) of the Income-tax Act, 1961, and/or as per any statutory modifications made in the Income-tax law from time to time.

b) Investments and documents of title shall be made and taken in the name of the Trust only.

CHAIRMAN CUM MANAGING TRUSTEE

- 28. The first named Founder cum Trustee Mr. A. ANBALAGAN, shall be the Chairman cum Managing Trustee.
- 29. He shall manage administer the Schools, Colleges any other Institutions as Correspondent or President.
- 30. The Chairman of the Trust shall have the power to appoint additional trustees provided that the total number or trustees for the time being shall not exceed 31. The vacancies among the trustees may be filled up by the Chairman except to the office of the Chairman.
- 31. Each of the Trustees appointed under provisions of these presents not being the Chairman of the Trust shall hold office until he is removed by the Chairman of the Trust shall hold office until he is removed by the Chairman of the Trust or he resigns voluntarily.
- 32. The Chairman cum Managing Trustee for the time being shall have the custody of all deeds and documents of title relating to Trust properties and investments and the books of account and other records relating to the Trust and shall be responsible for the same.
- 33. All income, subscriptions and pecuniary donations of the Trust and income from investments shall be paid into a banking account or accounts with any scheduled bank which the Trustees may determine unless immediately need for the purpose of the Trust.
- 34. With a view to carry out the objects of the Trust here-in-above mentioned and to augment its funds and to administer them the Managing Trustee shall have the power to appoint committees or sub-committees from among the Trustees and assign duties and seek suggestions for the purpose of working of the Trust.
- 35. a) If the functions of Managing Trustee is not satisfy to the other Trustee and against the objective of the Trust if they feel the Board of Trustee shall assemble and select the person from themselves as the Chairman cum managing trustee by two third majority and he shall hold the office of the Chairman for only two years.

b) If necessary, the Borad of Trustes may appoint a new member for the trust provided the total trustees shall not be more than thirty one.

36. This trust is IRREVOCABLE at any time and under any circumstance.

37. All amendments and modifications to this TRUST DEED shall be carried out only with the approval of the Commissioner of Income-Tax.

38. In the event of the happening of any impossibility or impracticability in carrying out of the objects of the Trust aforesaid, the properties appertaining to the Trust shall be transferred to another public charitable Trust or society with similar objectives which has been registered under the Income tax Act 1961 but in no case shall the assets of the Trust be divided among the Trustees.

39. No immovable and moveable properties belong to this trust as on date.

40. The Trust should not undertake any activity outside India.

41. This Trust shall not be a profit motive one.
